The National Census takes place every 10 years. Each household is asked to record information about who is living in their house on a particular date. This information is kept secret for 100 years and then becomes available.

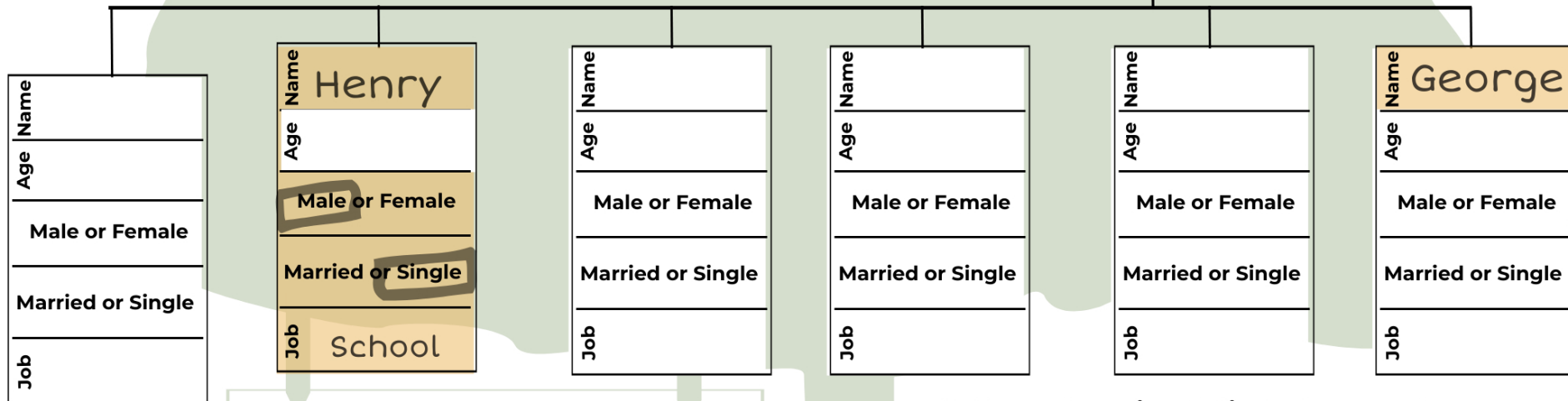
Historians find them really amazing because it gives them information about EVERY person in the country from a 100 or more years ago. This means they can follow the history of a family, street or area through time.
