

Discover Durham Live Role Description

We are offering an exciting opportunity for Durham Alumni to be involved in our Discover Durham Live online open day sessions.

We are holding a series of Discover Durham Live sessions for prospective Postgraduate and Undergraduate students and invite you to be a guest panelist. You may be joined by other Durham graduates; you will give a short introduction, answer questions and share your experiences on one of the following topics:

- Why you chose to study at Durham,
- Where has your degree taken you,
- Sharing your experiences of a year abroad.

The session will be hosted and moderated by a staff member from the central recruitment team. The session will be delivered online via MS Teams.

Role expectations:

Discover Durham Live: Why you chose to study at Durham sessions – contribute as part of an online session, to come prepared with a 3-5 minute presentation on your experience of Durham: why you chose to study here, a summary of your study/contact hours/academic support, your College experience, if you were involved in any sports/societies and answering questions from prospective students logging in from around the world.

Discover Durham Live: Where has your degree taken you sessions - contribute as part of an online session with other Alumni Ambassadors, introduce yourself, answer students' questions and share if you used the Careers and Enterprise Centre's support whilst at Durham.

Discover Durham Live: Study Abroad and Placement Years sessions - contribute as part of an online session with other Alumni Ambassadors, introduce yourself, answer students' questions about your year abroad.

Role criteria:

- Have completed a postgraduate or undergraduate course at Durham.
- Be available online using the Zoom webinar platform for 45 minutes using video and microphone.
- Be available to set up and log on from 15 minutes before your designated session begins.
- Present yourself with a friendly, positive attitude.
- Be able to confidently answer questions relating to study at Durham and the employability opportunities it may offer.
- Be open and honest about your experiences.

A full event briefing will be provided ahead of the online sessions, and you will have support from staff in the Recruitment and Admissions Team throughout.
