critically evaluate and apply different approaches to the close reading and interpretation of biblical texts, communicating these with relevance, rigour, creativity and sensitivity to a variety of audiences and contexts;

consolidate and extend competences and modes of inquiry in practices of Christian discipleship, mission and ministry in the light of theological and, where appropriate, other disciplines, in a range of complex and unpredictable contexts;

extend and apply their knowledge and understanding of key disciplines of theology, ministry and mission to new and complex contexts, reflecting critically on their impact on the life and ministry of the church, and showing sensitivity to the problems of religious language, experience, and the limits of knowledge. .

identify, gather, analyse and evaluate textual source materials, including material from primary sources and scholarly research, for a range of purposes, and communicate their findings with clarity and fairness using a variety of media to both specialist and non-specialist audiences.

take responsibility for an extended task that involves the exercise of initiative, independent inquiry, and the effective management of time, resources and use of IT; engaging with others in planning and decision-making in complex and unpredictable contexts; meeting deadlines; evaluating the task and learning from it. take responsibility for their own personal and professional development.

draw on key aspects of relevant disciplines to begin developing a critical analysis of contemporary situations, reflecting on practice and experience, in the context of discipleship, mission and ministry, recognising the importance of knowing the limits of their knowledge;

identify, gather, analyse and evaluate textual source materials for a range of purposes;

undertake a critical analysis of information and arguments, communicating these effectively to specialist and non-specialist audiences, showing critical self-awareness of their own beliefs, commitments and prejudices;;

take responsibility for a task that involves independent inquiry; the management of time, resources and use of IT; meeting deadlines; evaluating the task and learning from it;

plan their own personal and professional development.
