T3: Programme regulations 2024/25

BA (Hons) in Theology, Ministry and Mission (360 Credits)

- 1. This programme is available at Lindisfarne College of Theology in part-time and full-time mode of study.
- 2. This 360 credit programme requires a minimum of 90 credits at Level 6, and a maximum of 270 credits at Level 4 and/or 5.
- 3. All biblical language modules are delivered on-line.
- 4. Supervisions for dissertations, extended projects and independent learning projects are delivered through a blend of in-person and on-line meetings.
- 5. All other Level 4, 5 and 6 modules are delivered through in-person teaching.
- The TMM1437/TMM1417 Chaplaincy Placement set-up and closure tutorials and the TMM2531 & TMM3491 Long Placement set-up and closure tutorials are delivered through a blend of inperson and on-line tutorials.
- 7. The modules marked with Ω in levels 4 and 5 are those which are normally required of Ordinands and Licensed Lay Ministers in training. Other students will negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies according to module availability in any year of study. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors.
