

**Diploma in Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (240 credits)**

1. This programme is available at Lindisfarne College of Theology in part-time and full-time mode of study.
2. This 240 credit programme requires a minimum of 90 credits at Level 5, and a maximum of 150 credits at Level 4.
3. All biblical language modules and ILP modules are delivered on-line.
4. The TMM1437/TMM1417 Chaplaincy Placement set-up and closure tutorials and the TMM2531 Long Placement set-up and closure tutorials may be delivered through a blend of in-person and on-line tutorials.
5. All other Level 4 and Level 5 modules are delivered in-person.
6. The modules marked with Ω are those which we normally require of Ordinands and Licensed Lay Ministers in training who are taking the Diploma. Other students will negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies according to module availability in any year of study. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors.
