## Postgraduate Diploma in Theology, Ministry and Mission (120 Credits) V60412

This programme is available at **Sarum College** in full-time and part-time modes of study. Choice of modules is determined by the tutor, in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they are engaged, and previous learning. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors.

The method of delivery is Blended Learning – a combination of contextual learning, in-person teaching, online live video tutorials and online asynchronous learning material.
