T3: Programme regulations 2024-25

Diploma of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (240 credits)

This programme is available at **South Central TEI**, in full-time and part-time modes of study. Within the parameters of the regulations set out below, students will negotiate their choice of modules with their tutor, in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they are engaged, and module availability. Inclusion of at least one module at level 4 or 5 relating to Christian worship and marked with a * is required. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors.

There are three methods of delivery:

In Person Learning ¹ – Tutor and student(s) in physical space together. Online Learning ² – Interaction with tutor and fellow student on an IT platform. Blended Learning ³ – Combination of In Person and Online.

Centres deliver modules as follows, except where otherwise indicated with a ^{1,2,3} in the table: Guildford - In Person Oxford - In Person Winchester – Blended Learning
