

Certificate of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (120 credits)

1. This programme is available at the Scottish Episcopal Institute in a full-time or part-time mode of study.
2. Candidates shall study 120 credits at Level 4.
3. Candidates shall negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they already serve, and according to module availability in any year of study.
4. Modules which appear in more than one list may only be taken once.
