

Graduate Certificate in Theology, Ministry and Mission (60 credits)

1. This programme is available at the Scottish Episcopal Institute in a full-time (over half a year) or part-time (over two years).
2. Candidates shall study and be assessed in a maximum of 60 credits, with a minimum of 40 credits at Level 6 and a maximum of 20 credits at Levels 4 and 5.
3. Students will negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they already serve and according to module availability in any year of study.
4. Modules which appear on more than one list may only be taken once.
