

T3: Programme Regulations 2024-25

## Postgraduate Certificate in Theology, Ministry, and Mission

1. This programme is available at St Padarn's Institute in part-time mode of study.

The programme is delivered via a mixture of face-to-face and online teaching. Please see the Module Overview Table for more details.

Candidates should note that not all modules may be taught in each academic year and that the availability of the optional modules is dependent upon both demand and the availability of staff to teach them.

Candidates enrolled on the Children, Youth, and Families pathway will study and be assessed in modules from lists A and B and not from List C or List D.

Candidates enrolled on the Theology pathway will study and be assessed in modules from lists A and C and not from List B or List D.

Candidates enrolled on the Canon Law pathway will study and be assessed in modules from lists A and D and not from List B or List C.

## Level 7 (60 credits)

2. Candidates shall study and be assessed in the **compulsory** module to the value of 2**0 credits** from List A:
