Certificate of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (120)

- 1. This programme is available at SWMTC in part time (2 year) mode of study. There are Ministry students (LLMs/Readers) on an M pathway (Me, Mp or Mt) and Independent students on an I pathway. Modules are available every year but each module may only be taken <u>once</u>. All modules listed for a pathway (M or I) are compulsory for students following that pathway.
- 2. Most of these modules are taught through a blend of face-to-face classes (in person or on zoom) supported to varying extents by small groups meeting for reflective practice seminars; those marked * also have a significant amount of supported online learning, both synchronous and asynchronous. The exceptions are the Independent Learning Projects, which are supervised in person or by zoom, and those modules marked ** which are entirely supported learning online, although some elements may be synchronous.
