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Ambivalence of SETI

- Fascination with SETI has problematic consequences: popularization of the topic
- Scientific standards vs. popular culture
- Misunderstanding of SETI as fantasy research

Reasons for acceptance problems of SETI

- Failure to see the difference between science and science fiction
- Dangers of anthropomorphism
- Answer of science: entia non sunt multiplicanda praeter necessitatem



Countermeasures

- Transparency and verifiability of SETI and all kinds of research connected with it
- Educating the public; help people to realize the difference between science and popular culture
- Educating politicians: point out the dangers that could arise from neglecting the topic

Cultural perspectives

- Considerable impact on different religious and social traditions
- Philosophical questions
- Existential fears
- Insight into the relativity of human existence

Conclusion

- Paradox: Overwhelming probability of alien life vs. lacking acceptance of SETI as a serious scientific topic
- SETI allows new perspectives on our self-image: relativity of human existance on earth
 - Cosmopolitism
 - Different understanding of nature
 - Different attitude towards (other) animals
- These changes in our self-image do not depend on whether real contact with alien intelligence can be made in our lifetime
