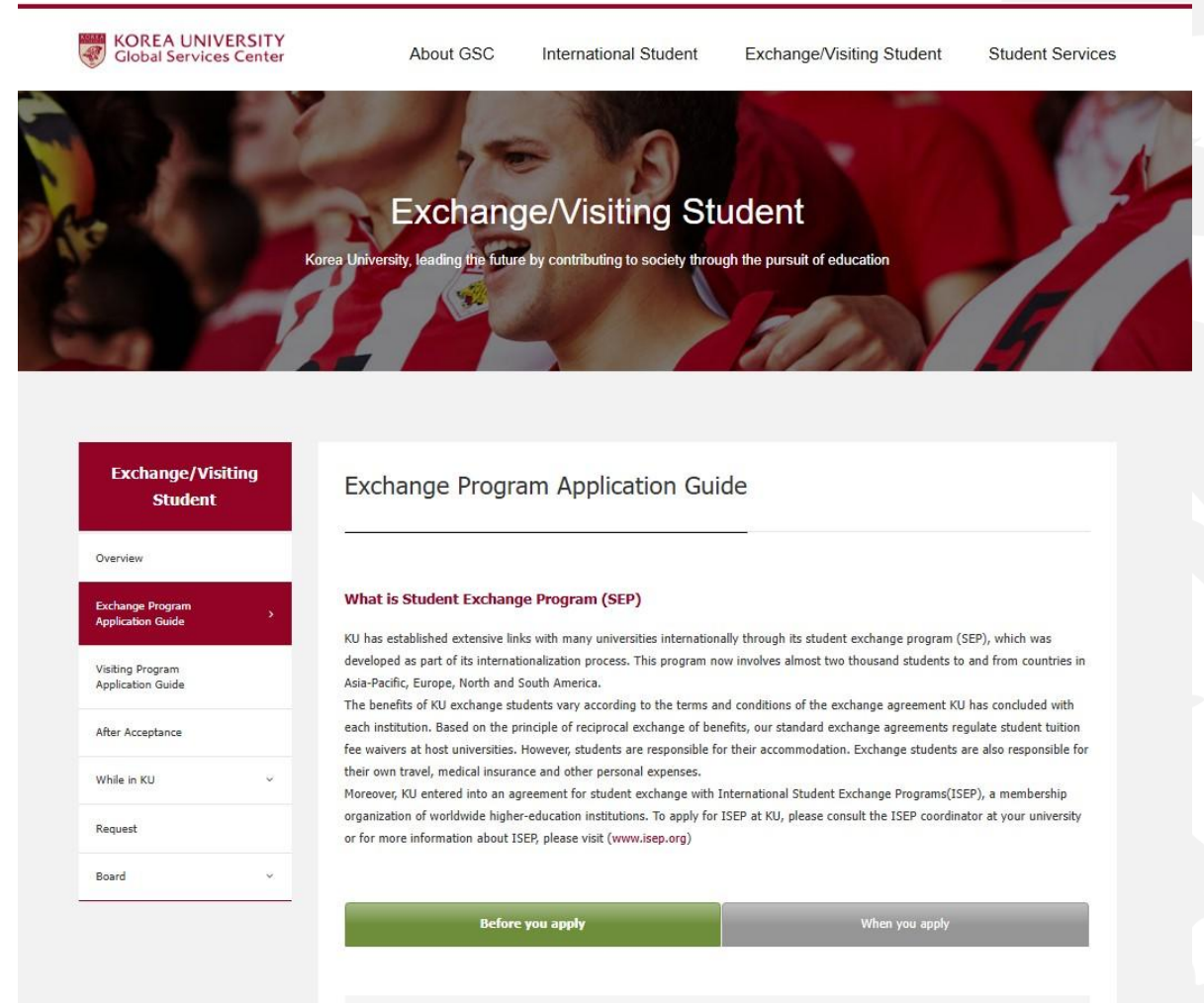

Entry Requirements

- **Must be a currently enrolled student**
- **A minimum CGPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale**
- **Undergraduates: a minimum of 2 full semesters**
(Transferred Undergraduates: 1 semester)
- **Fluency *either* in Korean *or* English**
▶ Evidence of language proficiency is not required.

Application Tips!

- **Submit the online application and the required documents *before* the deadline.**
- **Statement of Purpose (SOP)**
 - Must be 1 page only.
 - Why choose KU as a study abroad destination?
 - What do you hope to achieve at KU?

- Code of Conduct and Dismissal
- Copy of Passport
- Photo for KU Student ID Card
- Health Certificate
- Copy of Travel Insurance
- Bank Statement *for D-2 visa*
(USD 5,000 for 1 Semester & USD 10,000 for 2 Semesters)
- Global KU Scholarship Application
- Additional documents may be required for Non-OECD nationals.

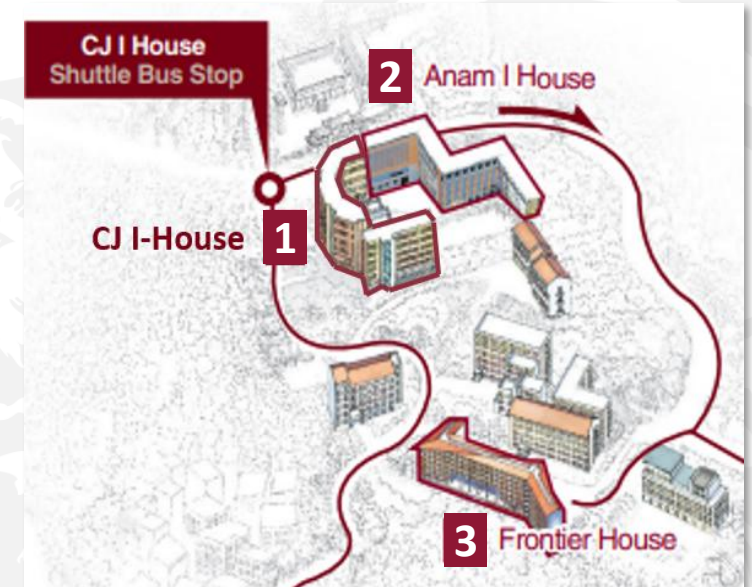
