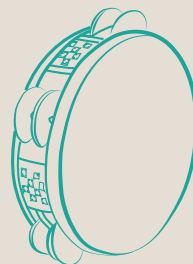

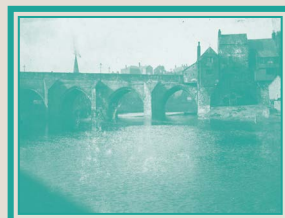

ARTIST FACT FILE!

Name: Dr Finola Finn

Finola is a Doctor of History

Her favourite part of history is early modern England (1486-1755) and she likes to learn about health, emotions and religion

She was born in Australia

She won a competition in 2017 to display her artwork in Durham for the Lumiere festival.

Finola made a giant plastic sculpture of a red heart which lights up. The giant glowing heart was then hung in a building called **THE COUNTS HOUSE**. She made this sculpture for a festival in Durham called **LUMIERE**. You can see it here...
